- **1. Apply to Texas A&M University at** https://www.applytexas.org: Create a new graduate school application and pay the application fee. Please note that the following information should be included on your application:
 - Target University: Texas A&M University (College Station)
 - Application Type: Graduate (choose U.S. or International)
 - Major: AGRONOMY, (NON-DEGREE SEEKING)
 - Test Scores:
 - o GRE: No test scores are required for Non-Degree Seeking admission
 - o TOEFL: Applicants whose native language is not English *may* be required to submit proof of English proficiency
 - Essay: A brief statement of purpose describing your field of interest and the objectives of your educational and professional career
 - Email LeAnn Hague, Distance Coordinator for the Department of Soil & Crop Sciences, leann.hague@ag.tamu.edu, to let her know that you've submitted your application
- 2. Submit official transcripts to one of the addresses below. Please note that all required documents must be received (not postmarked) by Admissions Processing by the appropriate closing date. To ensure that your official transcripts and other supporting documents are processed in a timely and efficient manner, please include a Document ID Sheet (attached) with all documents you submit in support of your application.
